# Non-commercial private broadcasting in Austria

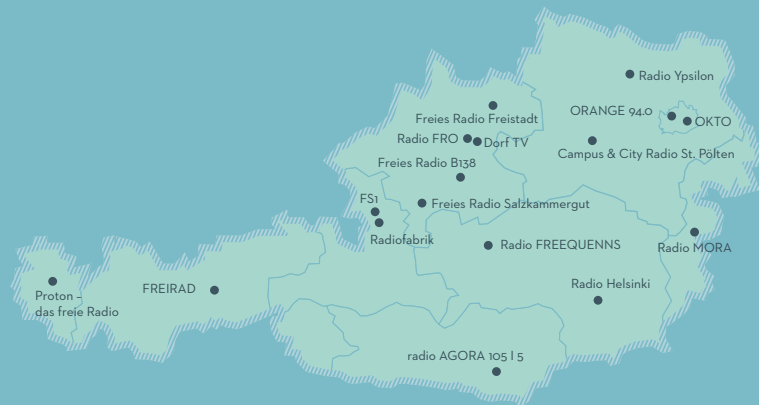

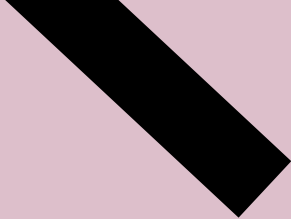
## Community Radio and Community TV stations contribute to
